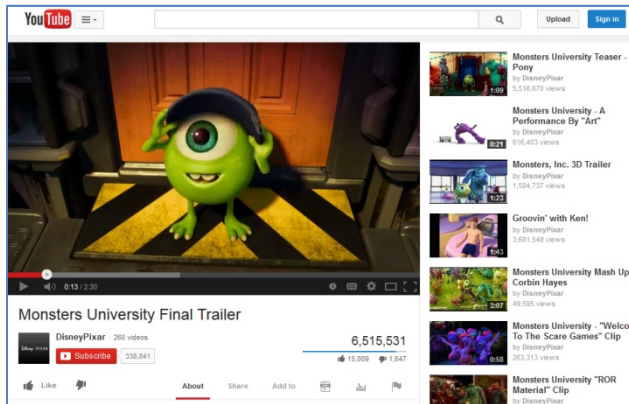


Adding a YouTube Video to Your Page


Find a Video on YouTube.com and Grab the Code

- Search for your video on youtube.com
- Click on the video you wish to embed




- Click Share Then Click on Embed
- Selected the video size (you can create a custom width to fit the space on your page)
- Uncheck 'Show suggested videos after video finishes'
- Select the iframe source code provided and copy it

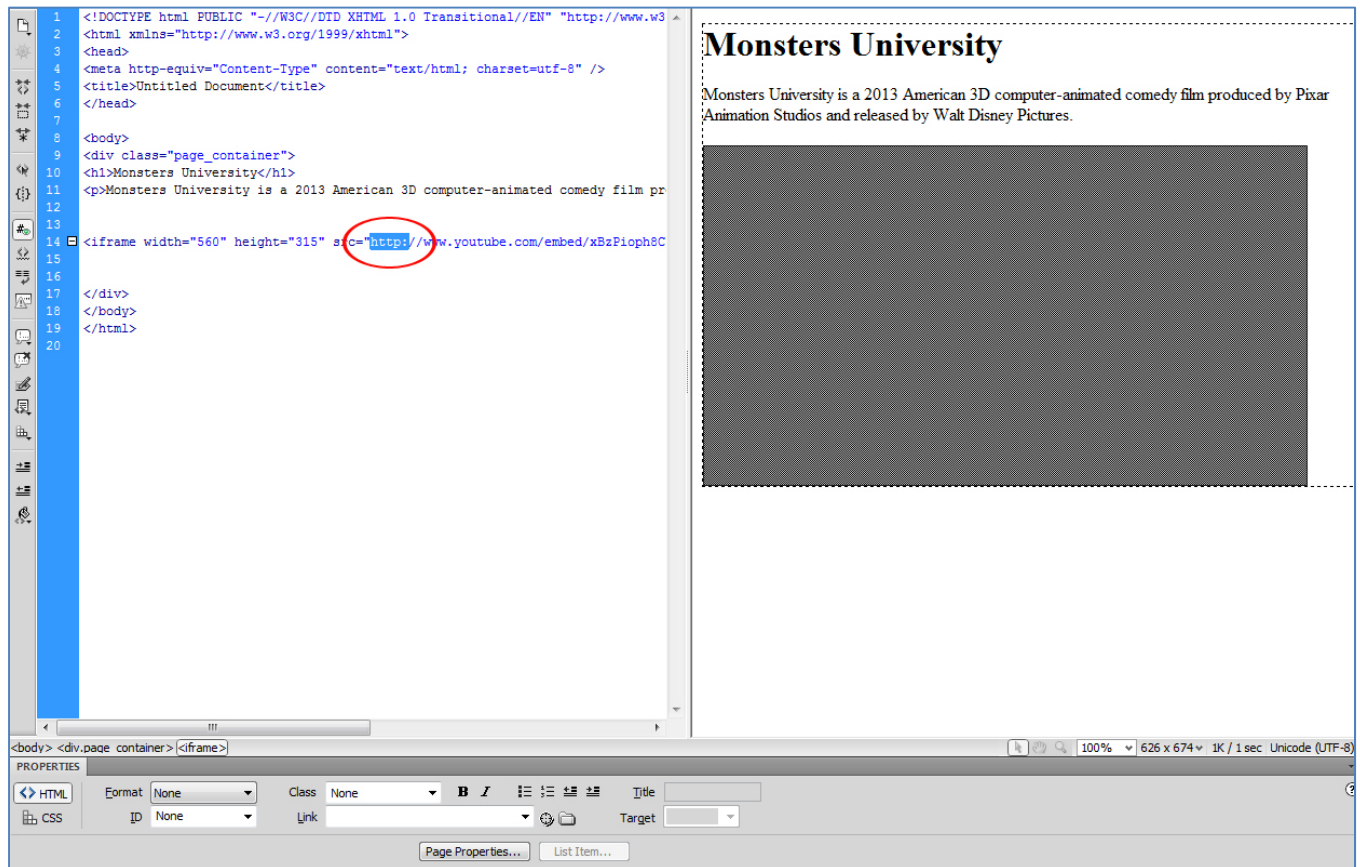

Add the Video to your Page in Dreamweaver

- In Design view place your cursor where you would like your video to be shown
- Switch to Split View and you should notice your cursor in the corresponding place in the code
- Paste the code you copied from YouTube into your code
- Remember to place the **http:** at the start of the src attribute in the iframe tag (see screenshot)
- Save your work



Notice that you will not see the video in your design view unless you put it in Live Mode. Your best bet is to preview your page in the browser to make sure the video is working correctly.
